
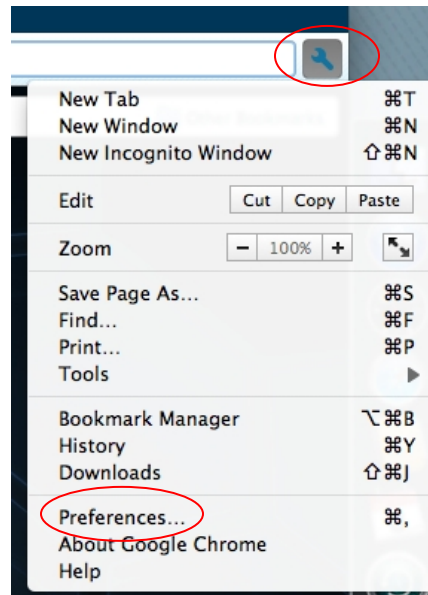
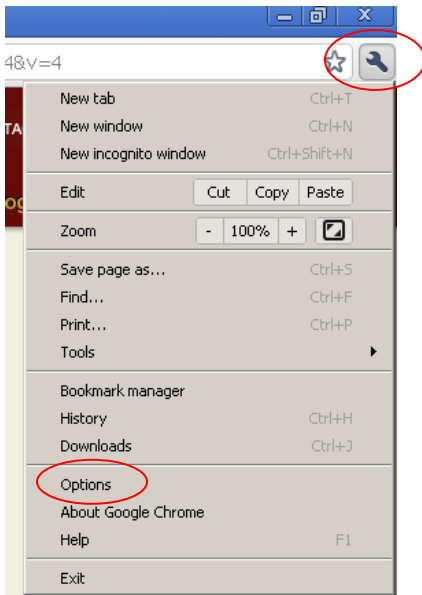


Adding Pop-up Blocker Exceptions

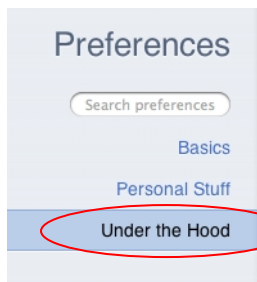


Chrome 10- Newer (Windows and Mac OS X)

1. Click on the **Wrench**  icon in the upper right of the window.
2. On the drop down, click on **Options** (Windows) or **Preferences** (Mac).



3. Click on **Under the Hood**. In the **Privacy** section, click on the button labeled **Content Settings...**

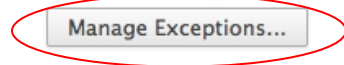

4. In the **Pop-ups** section click on the button labeled **Manage Exceptions**.

- Allow all sites to show pop-ups
 Do not allow any site to show pop-ups (recommended)

5. In **Pop-up Exceptions** type **secure3.onlineaccess1.com** into the field located under **Pattern**. Verify **Allow** is selected under **Behavior** and press **Enter** or **Return** (Mac) on your keyboard.
6. Repeat step 4 adding **statements.unitedfcu.com**. Once all exceptions have been added, close tab.
