
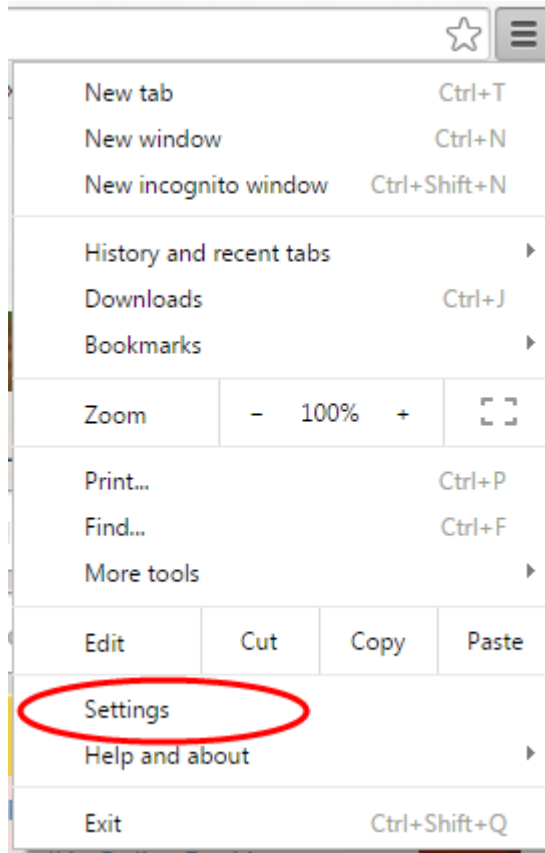


Google Chrome — Adding third party cookie exceptions

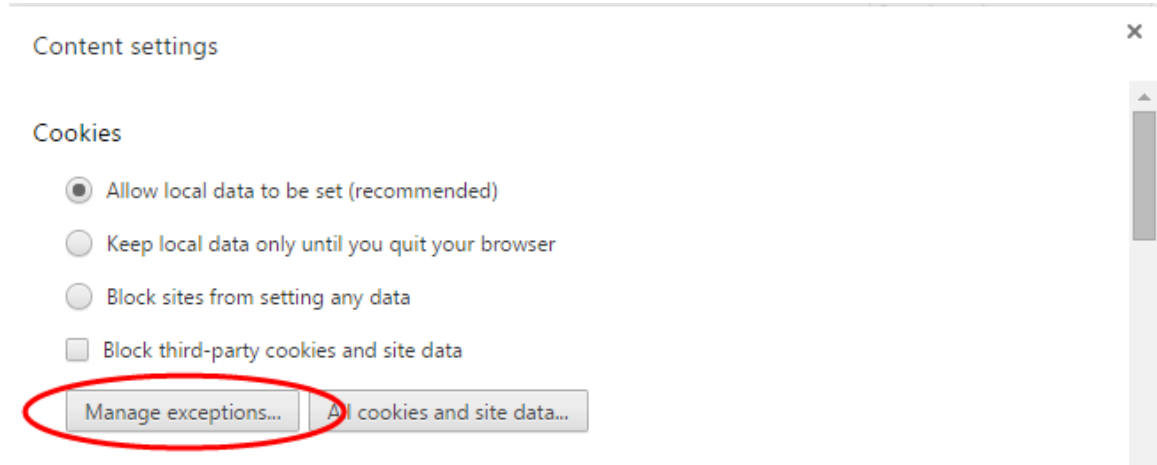
These settings are to be used if you are using custom settings that do not allow third party cookies.

1. Click on the **Setting Bars**  icon in the upper right of the window.
2. Within the settings dropdown menu select the **Settings** option.



3. Click on the [Show advanced settings...](#) link located near the bottom of the page.
4. Within the Privacy section, click on the button labeled Content Settings...

5. In the **Cookies** section, select **Manage Exceptions**.



6. On **Cookies and Site Data Exceptions** screen type **“secure3.onlineaccess1.com”** in the box under **Hostname pattern**. **Allow** should be displayed under **Behavior**. Press the **Enter** key to add the exception.

7. Repeat step 6 by adding **q2.billdomain.com**

8. Repeat step 6 by adding **statements.unitedfcu.com**

9. Once all Exceptions have been added, click on **Done**.
